



# Educare - Student Expectations

- Observe social distancing rules where possible. You should have no physical contact with any other student at any time.
- Wear a face covering at all times when moving around the school site. This should only be removed when you are sat in your classroom, at your desk, or when you are eating or drinking.
- Follow the one-way system in the school building, this is indicated by the arrows.
- Wash or sanitise your hands regularly throughout the day using soap or hand sanitiser.
- Sit in your allocated seat. If you need help, put your hand up – do not walk around the room or up to the teacher’s desk.
- Follow your normal school timetable, completing and engaging in all work set on Teams – always adhere to the remote learning expectations (if your teacher is in school please go to the relevant classroom).
- You must not share any equipment or other items, including drinking bottles and food, with other students.
- At break/lunchtime you must stay in your allocated area
- At all times you must treat each other and all members of staff with respect, in line with our usual school expectations.

## What happens if you cannot meet our expectations?

If you cannot meet our expectations, you pose a risk to the health and safety of yourself and others. The following procedure will be followed:

Action	Consequence
You fail to meet expectations once.	You will get a reminder from a member of staff (eg. to put your face covering back on when walking around the school building).
You <b>accidentally</b> fail to meet expectations a second time	You will receive a formal warning from a member of the leadership team; your parents/carers will receive a letter informing them that you have been formally warned and that any further failure to meet expectations may result in you no longer being able to attend Educare.
You <b>accidentally</b> fail to meet expectations a third or further time	You will no longer be able to attend Educare as your actions are a risk to the health and safety of others. Your parents/carers may be asked to come and collect you and they will receive a letter informing them that you are no longer able to attend school; this may be on a fixed-term or permanent basis. This can only be reviewed at the discretion of the Principal.

These consequences are based on **accidental** rule breaking. If you are deemed to have **deliberately broken school** rules, then you may be asked to immediately leave school site and you may receive a fixed-term or permanent ban from Educare. If you cannot make your own way home safely, you will be placed in isolation until you can be collected. Your parents/carers will be called, and they will receive a letter from Miss Adams informing them of this decision.
