





Literacy

In Literacy we will continue to use the text 'How to Train Your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell as a study aid to help write persuasive text.



After that, we will study 'The Journey of Edward Twane' using this text to help with the writing of recount and argumentative text.



Numeracy:

Children will develop skills to:

- Recognise and show (using diagrams), families of common equivalent fractions.
- Count up and down in hundredths.
- Solve problems involving increasingly harder fractions to calculate quantities, and fractions to divide quantities.
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.
- Recognise and write decimal equivalents of any number of tenths or hundredths.
- Solve simple measure and money problems.
- Convert between different units of measure.
