Jobs of the future

The world around us is rapidly evolving. Amid economic and global instability, and technology such as artificial intelligence (AI) now becoming part of our everyday lives, the future is uncertain.

Based on analysis by Jisc's graduate labour market specialist, Charlie Ball, [this report](#) sheds light on what the future of work may look like, areas of high employment growth, and the skills likely to be needed by employers over the next decade or so.

It follows our [report on the value of going to university](#), which showcased the current benefits of getting a degree.

Data at a glance

- By 2035, [more than 11 million extra graduates](#), in addition to the 15.3 million graduates currently in the UK workforce, will be needed to fill jobs in the UK by 2035 in industries such as computing and engineering, teaching and education, and health.
- [88% of new jobs](#) by 2035 will be at graduate level.
- [The UK will need over 1.9 million STEM professionals](#), including in areas such as computing and engineering, by 2035.
- [The UK will need over 1.2 million health and social care associate professionals](#), including opticians, medical technicians, housing officers and youth and community workers, by 2035.
- [The UK will need over 1 million health professionals](#) (such as doctors and nurses) by 2035.
- [The UK will need 1 million teaching and educational professionals](#), such as university and higher education teachers, by 2035.
- In the UK, due to AI, there will be a [10% net increase in jobs that require a degree over the next 20 years](#).

Five areas in need of graduates

Health

The UK will need over 1.2 million health and social care associate professionals, including opticians, medical technicians, housing officers and youth and community workers, by 2035.

The UK will need over 1 million health professionals (such as doctors and nurses) by 2035.

Education

The UK will need 1 million teaching and educational professionals, such as university and higher education teachers, by 2035.

Globally, there will be 3 million more jobs for vocational education teachers and university and higher education teachers by 2027.

Digital

In the UK, due to AI, there will be a 10% net increase in jobs that require a degree over the next 20 years.

Globally, there will be 4 million more digitally-enabled roles by 2027.

Creative skills

A university degree teaches transferable skills, such as the creative and critical thinking needed for problem-solving.

The UK will need over 1.2 million business services associate professionals, including professionals in advertising and marketing, by 2035.





Prominent UK high-street brand Superdrug has committed to create apprenticeship employment opportunities through its newly launched 'Rise Up to Level Up' campaign.

The ambitious campaign aims to boost apprenticeship employment across the UK by hiring 500 apprentices.

In partnership with the British Retail Consortium, the initiative will double apprenticeship roles in high-unemployment areas over the next three years, targeting regions where 859,000 young people are currently without work or education.

The initiative will target five key areas characterized by high rates of youth unemployment, with the goal of providing tangible solutions to mitigate this issue.

Superdrug launched its apprenticeship program in 2007, leading to more than 4,500 individuals entering and successfully attaining qualifications.

The recently launched campaign will focus on London, Norfolk, Suffolk, Essex, and the south coast. Surprisingly, despite the brand's extensive store presence, the adoption of apprenticeships in these areas remains low.

Amy Davies, the People Director for Superdrug and Savers, expressed enthusiasm about the initiative's potential impact, stating, "Our apprenticeship programmes are specifically designed to help, support and train every apprentice whilst they earn, to rapidly get where they want to in their careers and to cultivate and nurture the next generation of leaders in retail."

"Apprenticeships are such a great choice for young people as they leave school and statistics show they are needed now more than ever - so as a business that stands for equality and accessibility, we remain committed to doing what we can to increase our intake and improve our scheme." Helen Dickinson OBE, CEO of the British Retail Consortium, said: "Retailers have a wealth of exciting apprenticeships on offer. We are proud to support this ambitious scheme, which will showcase the wide range of career options within retail and grow the number of apprenticeship places, giving hundreds more young people and applicants from disadvantaged backgrounds a rewarding start to their careers."

Retail buyer

Retail buyers are essential to the success of a retail business as they ensure appropriate products are sourced at the right price.

Working as a retail buyer, you'll plan and select a range of products to sell in retail outlets. You'll need to consider several factors when making purchasing decisions including customer demand, including price, quality, and availability. Market trends, store policy and financial budgets are other considerations and restraints.

You'll also source new merchandise and review existing items to ensure products remain competitive. By fully understanding customer needs, you will maximise profits and provide a commercially viable range of merchandise at competitive prices.

Responsibilities

As a retail buyer you'll need to:

- analyse consumer buying patterns and predict future trends
- regularly review performance indicators, such as sales and discount levels
- manage plans for stock levels
- keep up to date with market trends and react to changes in demand and logistics
- meet suppliers and negotiate terms of contract
- maintain relationships with existing suppliers and source new suppliers for future products
- understand the basic rules of vendor management, allocation and price negotiation
- liaise with other departments within the organisation to ensure projects are completed
- attend trade fairs, in the UK and overseas, to select and assemble a new collection of products
- participate in promotional activities
- write reports and forecast sales levels
- present new ranges to senior retail managers
- liaise with shop personnel to ensure supply meets demand
- obtain feedback from customers
- train and mentor junior staff
