APPRENTICESHIP FACTS DID YOU KNOW?

The Army offers 39 different apprenticeship standards from Level 2 through to a Level 6 Chartered Manager Degree Apprenticeship.

The first temporary Apprentice College opened in Aldershot in 1923 and across a total of 65 years there has been 16 Apprenticeship colleges, spread right across the UK. Now the Army offers Modern Apprenticeships which are delivered in Initial Trade Training Schools and in the workplace.

95% of recruits will be enrolled on an apprenticeship.

The Army takes on over 6,000 apprentices each year with an impressive 77% completion rate.

A Level 2 apprenticeship is equivalent to 5x GCSE passes and will take 18-24 months to complete. You earn while you learn.

106,945 soldiers have completed their modern apprenticeships since 2004.

GCSEs or Functional Skills are not required to join the Army.

CV stands for curriculum vitae. That's Latin for your 'course of life' and that's basically what the document does. It tells people who you are and what you've done up to the point of applying.

What should your CV include?

- Name
- Contact details
- Personal profile
- Key skills
- Education
- Work experience
- References
- Hobbies and interests/achievements

You DO NOT need to include your age, date of birth or nationality. Employers shouldn't consider those things when deciding to offer you an interview. You also don't need to include a photo.

What should your CV look like?

There's no need to try and stand out with jazzy fonts and fluorescent paper. Your CV should be clear and easy to read.

Your CV should:

- Be no longer than two pages.
- Use an easy-to-read font like Arial or Times New Roman. The font should be black and sized between 10-12.
- Use headings and bullet points. Keep the layout simple and make it easy to read.
- Use plain language.



Wot Wud U Do is a Community Interest Company (CIC) dedicated to creating meaningful change in young people's lives. As a CIC, our resources and revenues are reinvested for the public good, ensuring every programme we deliver makes a lasting impact.

We collaborate with local authorities, schools, health services, and community organizations across Lancashire to design and deliver structured programmes that address real challenges and empower young people. From tackling anti-social behavior to building leadership skills and emotional resilience, our work focuses on creating opportunities for growth, connection, and transformation.

Participants Wanted for Preston Photography Project

A new participatory, co-produced community photography project is offering residents and newcomers to Preston an opportunity to share their first impressions of the city through the lens of a camera.

The project, run by Preston-based Wot Wud U, aims to capture the thoughts, feelings, and experiences of those who are new to Preston – including refugees, immigrants, students, workers, and visitors – by using photography as a tool for self-expression.

Through a series of free workshops, the project invites participants to express their opinions on both the positives and negatives of living in Preston, by creating their own images that reflect their unique perspectives on the city.

Participants will see their images displayed around the historic Winckley Square.

The project kicks off with a free street photography walk in Preston, guided by professional photographer Garry Cook, on Saturday, March 01, 2025.

With guidance from Cook and local experts, participants will be empowered to share their stories and raise awareness of the issues that matter most to them.

The findings from the project will be used to inform local decision-makers and services, helping them to improve the experience for those new to Preston.

By bringing together diverse voices through creative expression, the project aims to foster a sense of community, improve social connections, and highlight areas where the city can grow.

During the project, participants will be offered hands-on photography advice, learning key skills in a series of practical workshops. These sessions will cover everything from basic photography techniques to how to tell a personal story through images. Participants will also have the opportunity to meet others, build new friendships and develop life skills.

As well as providing valuable insights into people's impressions of Preston as a city, it will also help increase awareness of social issues, reduce social isolation, develop skills and create community connections across Preston.

The project will begin with several workshops in March, culminating in an outdoor exhibition around May 2025.

CAREER of the WEEK

Dentist

Dentists prevent and treat problems affecting the mouth and teeth, deal with injuries and correct dental issues.

As a dentist, you'll typically lead a team of dental nurses, hygienists, therapists and technicians, and treat a range of patients, from children to the elderly.

The most common role in dentistry is as a general dental practitioner (GDP). As a GDP, you'll work as a self-employed contractor providing dental care to the general public in high street practices. It's also possible to work part time in hospitals. You might provide services under the NHS, privately or both.

Types of dentistry

You may choose to specialise in a different area of dentistry, such as:

- Community dental care working in patients' homes, nursing homes and community clinics, treating patients who have special requirements that mean they can't attend a high street practice.
- Dental public health carrying out non-clinical work, assessing the dental health needs of populations rather than individuals.
- Hospital dental care dealing with cases of special difficulty and providing treatment to long-stay hospital patients, emergency treatment for short-stay patients or the general public for teaching purposes.
- Armed forces providing a comprehensive range of dental services for armed forces personnel in the UK and abroad, operating as a military dental officer.
- Academic dentistry teaching dental students and trainees within a university or dental hospital setting, often part time alongside clinical responsibilities

Responsibilities

As a dentist, you'll need to:

- educate patients on oral healthcare
- examine teeth, diagnosing dental conditions using tools such as x-rays
- assess treatment options and agree treatment plans with patients
- carry out agreed clinical treatments such as restoring teeth affected by decay and treating gum disease
- maintain patients' dental records
- recruit, train and manage staff
- oversee budgets and maintain stocks of equipment
- market services to potential clients.
- Some practices employ practice managers so that dentists can concentrate on clinical work
