





WHAT YOU NEED TO JOIN

EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW.

Student Nurse (Soldier): Complete your degree with us, earning money and with no tuition fees. You will need 120 UCAS points plus 3 GCSEs Grades 9-4 including Maths, English Language and one of the following: Health and Social Care, Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Science double/triple award or equivalent.

Bursary (Officer): If you have already gained your Student Nurse university place, are in the process of applying or are part way through your training you are eligible to apply for an Army Nursing Bursary of up to £42,000. You will join as a Nursing Officer once you qualify.

There are also routes to join as a Registered Nurse (Soldier or Officer).





I did my degree in Adult Nursing at Birmingham City University, which the Army paid for as well as giving me a wage. This meant I graduated with no student debt. I'm now working in an NHS hospital, but about to deploy overseas. George, Army Nurse

SALARY AND BENEFITS

Student Nurse (Soldier): around £16,000 during initial soldier training, over £21,000 a year during university, and over £32,000 upon qualification and first posting.

Bursary (Officer): Around £27,000 during officer training, rising to a minimum of £35,000 depending on experience. (Plus Army Nursing Bursary of up to £42,000 during university.)






CAREER of the WEEK

OCEANOGRAPHER

Oceanographers use science and mathematics to study and explain the complex interactions between seawater, fresh water, polar ice caps, the atmosphere and the biosphere.

Your role as an oceanographer is to understand and predict how the world's oceans and seas work, as well as to work out how to make the most efficient and sustainable use of their resources.



You can choose to specialise in one area of oceanography, such as:

- physical studying the properties of currents, waves, tides and ocean circulation, plus the temperature, density and salt content of oceans
- chemical determining the chemical composition of sea water and sediments and effect of pollutants
- biological studying the types and numbers of marine animals and plants that live in the oceans and how these organisms interact, adapt and react with their environment
- geological examining the seabed, including the rocks and minerals, in order to understand the relationship between the ocean and seafloor.
- Oceanography is a wide-ranging subject that can involve mineral exploitation, shipping, fisheries, coastal construction, pollution, weather prediction, climate change and renewable energy.





Qualifications

You'll usually need a degree in a subject such as oceanography, ocean science, geology, biology, chemistry, environmental science, marine sciences, geography, maths or physics. It's also possible to take a degree in ocean science, oceanography or marine science combined with other earth sciences.

There are many postgraduate courses to choose from, including some overseas ones. Courses cover physical, chemical and biological oceanography as well as areas such as computing, mathematical modelling and remote sensing.
