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Read this report from *BBC News* about increased levels of Christian persecution (ill treatment of Christians around the world).



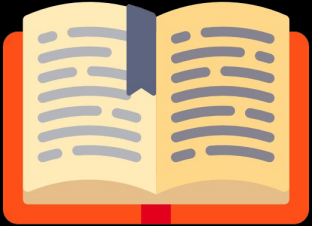
Watch this video looking at different religious beliefs about homosexuality. This is particularly relevant to Year 10 in their current study of Theme A: *Relationships and Families*.

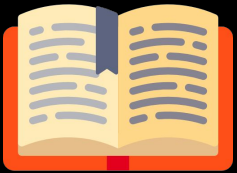
