#### **Year 11 Predictions**

- □ Progress Score +0.4
  - This means that, on average, each year 11 is predicted to achieve almost half a grade HIGHER than students at other schools up & down the country
  - ☐ This would be a <u>HUGE</u> improvement on last year's Year 11 cohort
- 21% are predicted grades 9 7 in both English & Maths
- 61% are predicted grades 9 5 in both English & Maths
- ☐ 79% are predicted grades 9 4 in both English & Maths
