

Behaviour Policy Update - COVID-19 September 20

Standards of Behaviour

- Pupils must respect each other and their teaching staff. The re-zoning of the school has been done according to the guidance from the DfE.
- ALL pupils MUST adhere to the 'bubble' zones.
- Pupils must stay in their zones and allocated spaces during social time. Failure to adhere to the zones will result in possible exclusion from school. Parents will be expected to immediately collect pupils who have compromised the health and safety of others. If parents are unable to collect the pupil, then the pupil will be sent home regardless.
- Parents of those pupils whose BfL is consistently poor will be required to attend a meeting with the head and the behaviour lead. Pupils who then fail to improve their BfL may be excluded.
- The Isolation room will still be in operation, pupils will form a 'bubble' for the time that they are required to be in there.

Red Card/Sent out of Lesson

- Pupils who are asked to leave the lesson will be removed by a HAL/SLT to another class in their zone (yellow card) OR will be assigned to a member of SLT/Isolation for the day (red card). Parents may be required to collect their child from school should the breach be serious or repeated. This will be an exclusion and will be subject to a parental meeting with the head/behaviour lead.

Social Strikes

- Social Strikes will still be used as a sanction. However, they will not be given for wearing coats in the school building or misuse of the one-way system. Pupils found out of their zones will be given a Social Strike in the first instance.
- Social Strike detentions will take place in the gym, where pupils will sit in year groups.
