UIHAT IS AN Apprenticeship? 8 key facts you need to know

An apprenticeship is a real job

Available to individuals aged 16+ (with no upper age limit), apprentices are typically employed for at least 30 hours per week.

Apprentices are paid a salary

All apprentices will earn a salary of at least the National Minimum Wage for apprentices which is currently £4.30* per hour. Many employers pay more!

Apprenticeships last a minimum of 12 months

Most apprenticeships take between 1 - 4 years to complete. It will depend on the level and delivery model of the apprenticeship.

Apprenticeships range from level 2 to level 7

There are apprenticeships at levels equivalent to GCSEs right up to Master's level and you can now achieve a degree through an apprenticeship.

Apprentices do not pay for their training

All apprenticeship costs are paid for by the employer and/or the government meaning that an apprentice will never have to pay for their training.

Apprentices will receive 20% off-the-job learning 20% of an apprentice's paid time will be spent undertaking off-the-job learning, gaining valuable skills and gualifications.

Apprentices will spend 80% of their time on-the-job

80% of an apprentice's paid time will be spent on-the-job, working with colleagues to learn new skills and gain experience of the workplace.

*The National Minimum Wage for apprentices is reviewed each April.

Virtual Work Experience Days

Last year some of our students participated in the <u>largest virtual work experience programme for aspiring</u> <u>medics, dentists and veterinary students</u>. These programmes were used by 15,000 students in the last academic year, to help them make an informed decision about their careers.

It is also the largest widening access programme in the country, because it is **free for any student** from any background. The virtual work experience programme was a resounding success, and feedback from students and teachers has been overwhelmingly positive.

Health Education England have also acknowledged that virtual work experience programmes are an excellent adjunct to in-person work experience, and we believe that they are also valuable because of their accessibility to all. The Medical Schools will also be accepting virtual work experience as valuable insight opportunities as part of applications this year.

Applications for the free live virtual work experience programmes have now reopened for Year 10 students.



Free Live Virtual Work Experience Programmes for Medicine, Dentistry and Veterinary Medicine

Applications are now open for Academic Year 2021-2022 to participate in the UK's largest national virtual work experience programmes. These are ideal for any aspiring year 10 student considering a career in Medicine, Dentistry or Veterinary Medicine.
