ENROLMENT at WIGAN & LEIGH COLLEGE

We can confirm that we will once again be undertaking a face to face enrolment process as this is the best way to ensure that the right advice and guidance has been given and that all factors have been considered when deciding upon the course and level.

In light of the recent announcement confirming that GCSE results will be issued on Thursday 12th August we have changed our enrolment period to coincide with results. Therefore, the enrolment period at college this year will be

from Thursday 12th August 2021 - Saturday 14th August 2021.

At this stage we do not know what COVID restrictions will be in place in August but we intend to run the same adapted COVID safe process as we did last year:

Applicants will be invited into college at specific timeslots and will be required to bring in their GCSE results slip. Applicants will not be able to access the enrolment process outside of their timeslot. This will enable us to implement appropriate social distancing measures and maximise safety.

There will be a streamlined enrolment process with reduced stations and interactions to implement all public health requirements. However all students will still receive 1:1 guidance from our careers teams and/or course tutors. If any applicant cannot make their allotted enrolment time, they can contact us for a different time during the 3-day enrolment period. Applicants for apprenticeships will be supported in trying to secure an employment vacancy. We are confident that there will still be vacancies and we would urge those pupils who wish to apply for an apprenticeship to submit an application. We guarantee a place on a study programme at college for those applicants who do not secure employment and will continue to search for a vacancy during their first year at college.

Ever thought of starting your own business? Here's the story of Just Bee Honey and how they had to adapt to the changes over the last year.



IT ALL STARTED BACK IN 2015...

We launched Just Bee back in 2015 with two simple goals; to create exciting and

healthy products using honey; and an ongoing mission to help Save the Bees.

Three generations of British beekeepers!

Our idea to start Just Bee was inspired by Joe's (cofounder) family, who have a long history in beekeeping. Joe's dad is a beekeeper in Lancashire and his Grandad, Osbourne, was a beekeeper before him in Ireland. So as a third generation beekeeper, Joe and his family had a deep understanding of honey, beekeeping and the vital importance of bees and the threat of extinction that they are facing...

2016...

We spent over six months of evenings and weekends developing different concepts for Just Bee, from our initial weird and wonderful ideas, to a fully realised brand before launching our very first product; Just Bee flavoured water. Our flavoured water Just Bee drinks used a drop of honey as a natural sweetener instead of artificial sweeteners or refined sugars.

Knocking on doors of local delis, cafes, as well as artisan markets locally around the Manchester area we started selling our drinks door to door and doing deliveries from the boot of Joe's car!

We grew the brand slowly but steadily during our first year and in August 2015 we succeeded in getting our Just Bee drinks stocked in Fortnum & Mason, a very prestigious London based department store that were excited to sell the UK's first honey infused spring water drinks brand. Our pitch to Fortnum & Mason was simply "you have beehives on your store roof, so you should sell our honey drinks" and to our amazement, they said yes!





2017...

The first two years saw steady growth in our new business and in 2017 we appeared on TV's Dragon's Den, to look for further help and investment to grow the Just Bee brand.







That was a fantastic experience and most of the Dragons really loved our drinks, brand and ethics. We were offered the full amount of financial investment we were looking for by dragon Peter Jones, but ultimately we wouldn't give up such a large percentage of the business, so we said "thanks, but no thanks!" and walked away.

We are often asked if we regret turning him down and in all honesty we don't. The whole Just Bee ethos has always been about much more than money, we had faith in our business and we saw it as his loss, not ours.

2018-19...

Although we didn't end up working with any of the Dragons, appearing on the show gave us national publicity and it created new opportunities and interest from many supermarkets and large high street shops. Suddenly all the supermarket buyers weren't too busy to talk to us and were interested to hear about our drinks.





Over the next two years we saw some exciting growth for our Just Bee drinks, with them being sold in Selfridges' food courts across the country as well as Waitrose, Sainsbury's, Co-op, WH Smith and even Boots as part of their popular meal deal!



For many businesses 2020 was a very difficult year. The national lock-down during spring because of the Covid-19 virus meant that our drinks business almost completely collapsed overnight. Our drinks were typically the type of products that people buy while 'on the go' or out and about. Not great when everybody in the country was being told to stay at home! Our sales dropped by 80% literally overnight.

Demand continued to dry up as people worked from home and commuted less, orders from some of our biggest partners were reduced to zero as their own business struggled. During the Summer of 2020 (usually our busiest time of year) sales continued to be only a tiny fraction of what we had been selling the year before.

Unfortunately the Just Bee drinks business became unsustainable in this climate and we had to take the difficult decision to stop selling the drinks that had been such a big part of the Just Bee story for the first 5 years.

LAUNCHING JUST BEE HONEY...

But, as Billy Ocean once sang, 'When the going gets tough, the tough get going' and we weren't about to let the Just Bee brand that we had put so much hard work into finish there.

Since we first started Just Bee, people were always asking us "do you sell the honey as well as the drink?" We'd thought about it often and we had started developing our Vitamin Honey in 2019. Now it seemed the right time to turn a big set back into an opportunity!



We used the time during lockdown to launch our range of raw honey and the reaction and sales were immediately positive. Starting exclusively with online direct sales meant that we weren't relying on orders from big retailers and other businesses and people wouldn't have to leave their homes to purchase their honey.

Just Bee Raw Vitamin Honey

Demand for our Raw Vitamin Honey grew throughout 2020 as people sought out products that would naturally boost their immune system and provide a healthier way to sweeten their diets. During 2020 online sales of honey became the main focus for Just Bee.

We added our certified New Zealand Manuka raw vitamin honey to the range and heading into winter and the dreaded cold and flu season, we added our delicious lemon and ginger vitamin honey, which is perfect for

stirring into hot water for a natural cold and sore throat fighting drink.

While the products might have changed for Just Bee, the core ideals of our business didn't. Offering healthy honey products and helping to protect the bee population.

OUR ONGOING MISSION...

Today it is still our ongoing mission to help Save the Bees and to reverse the decline in the bee population in Britain.

As we always have done, we use a portion of the sales we make to buy bee-friendly wildflower seeds. These are sent out free of charge with every honey order, so all our customers can play an active role in our company's ethos and mission.

Even if you aren't a honey customer we will still send you a free packet of seeds for just a small postage charge. We also stand by our commitment to plant at least one bee-friendly seed for every pot of honey we sell. Together, with your help, we can achieve our goal of creating thousands of new bee-friendly wildflower patches across the UK and help stop the decline in bee numbers.

Our bees here in the UK and around the world are extremely important, not just for honey producers, but for also for the wider environment we live in.




Students will receive certificates as evidence of having participated in the work experience programme. Places are just £10 a day to cover administrative costs and run the tech on the day.

Study Smarter! Top Tips to Help You Prepare for Assessments

What a year it has been! Whether you are about to sit your final assessments, or general classroom assessments here are some tips and tricks from the globalbridge team to help you get through it.

We've all been there countless times before yet it never gets any easier; finding the motivation to study when you're just not in the mood is tough! There are a million and one things that you'd rather be doing with your time but you know that you have assessments looming!

So, what do you do?

Well, for a start, you begin reading this post and then afterwards, you pick up your textbook and your pen and you stop looking for excuses, because after reading this, you'll have all the study motivation you'll need to get started!

1. Break it Down into Small Steps

Okay, open your book, switch on your device, pens and paper ready!

Sounds simple, right? Well, that's all it takes to start studying. All you need to do is get into the right frame of mind. Rather than thinking of your studying as a whole assignment, think of it as a series of smaller tasks that when completed, will enable you to spend your time however you like.

'The secret to getting ahead is getting started'.

As you start to complete all of the smaller tasks on your list, you'll start to feel like you're making progress, which not only makes time pass quicker, but helps you retain information better. As you start ticking off all those tasks, your motivation for studying will gradually increase as the finish line starts getting ever so closer. Have a reward ready, a chocolate bar, an episode of your favourite programme.

2. Chew some gum!

Can't sit still while revising? Studies have found that chewing gum can improve your ability to concentrate for long periods. People who chewed gum performed better and more accurately on longer tasks than those who didn't. So why not give it a try next time you revise? Just maybe don't try it in an exam!!

3. Change Up Your Fonts

Reading through your notes can be relentless. Especially when you realise you haven't remembered a thing. But don't worry! Research has shown that a harder to read font can help your brain retain information more easily. It has been researched that students who studied in fonts like comic sans did better than those who didn't. Scientists think this is because it gets us to actually think about the information as opposed to just reading it. So, next time you're typing up notes why not do it in impact?

4. Switch Up Your Study Space

Don't just stick to studying in your room or at the library! Switching up where you study can actually help you remember things better. In one study, university students who memorised a list of words in two different places did better on tests than those who memorised in one room. By studying the same material in different places, your

brain forms different memories of the same thing. Which makes it easier to remember!

5. Test Yourself

Honestly this does actually work! Setting yourself small self-tests throughout a period of time can mean you will perform better on the big exams. Don't just do it once! Research shows that if you repeat the same test over a few weeks the easier it will be to remember the information.

6. Go Old School

These days a lot of our note taking is done on our tablets or laptops. But we don't want to throw handwriting out the window just yet. Writing down your notes by hand can help your brain understand heavy concepts. While your computer is fine for simple facts, handwriting can help you remember the bigger questions like "What are the themes of Shakespeare's Macbeth?"

7. Stay Hydrated

Even being a tiny bit dehydrated can decrease your ability to perform simple tasks and form memories. Don't think you can't get away with just drinking tea or fizzy drinks! Water is the best way to keep up your fluid levels. Keep a bottle next to your desk, and try to keep drinking it throughout the day.

8. Listen to Some Tunes (6)

You've probably heard the old tale that classical music can help you concentrate, it is partly true. Music can help you focus. But the good news is, it only works with music you like! Researchers have found that people who listen to their favourite music can concentrate for longer periods than those who don't. So don't worry, you can ditch the Beethoven for now!!

9. The Egg Timer Method

Once you have all your study materials ready to go, set yourself a specific time period that you will study for without stopping. We recommend setting yourself twenty minute periods as research has shown that the average human adult can sustain their concentration level for a maximum of twenty minutes.

'Never do tomorrow what you can do today!'

Next, you need to get your egg timer (or stopwatch, or mobile phone) and set yourself twenty minutes to study. You'll be amazed at how much you can achieve when you're completely focused on one thing for a set amount of time.

If this method works for you, then take a 5-10 minute break between each twenty minute period and before you know it, you'll have dedicated a whole hour to studying.
