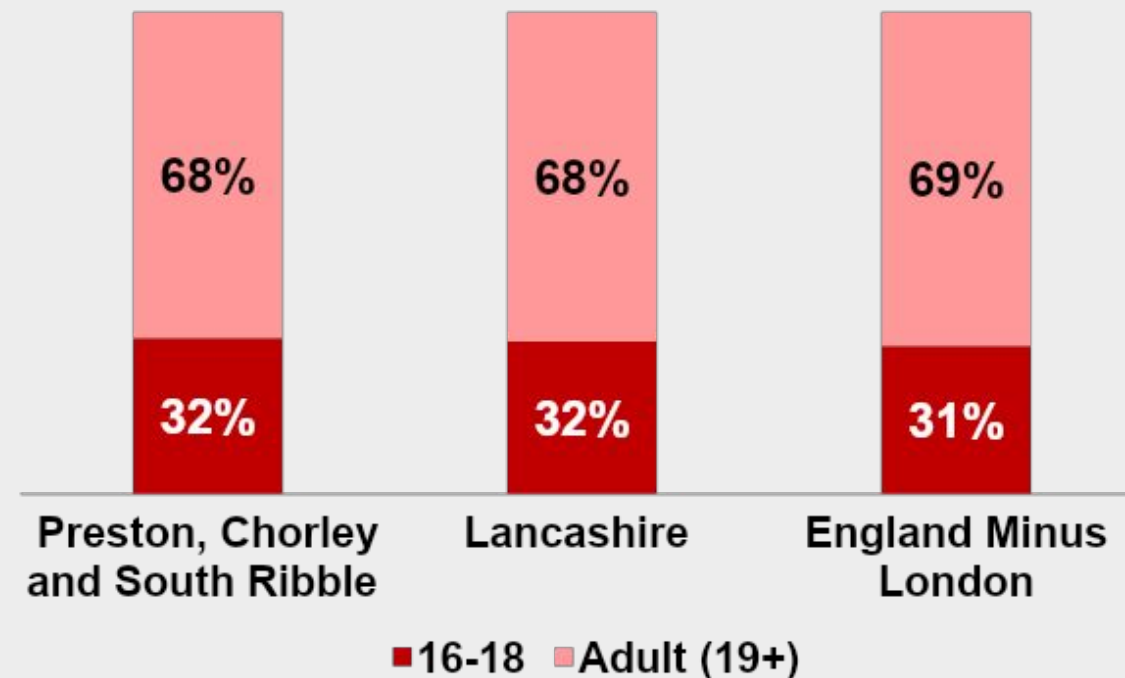
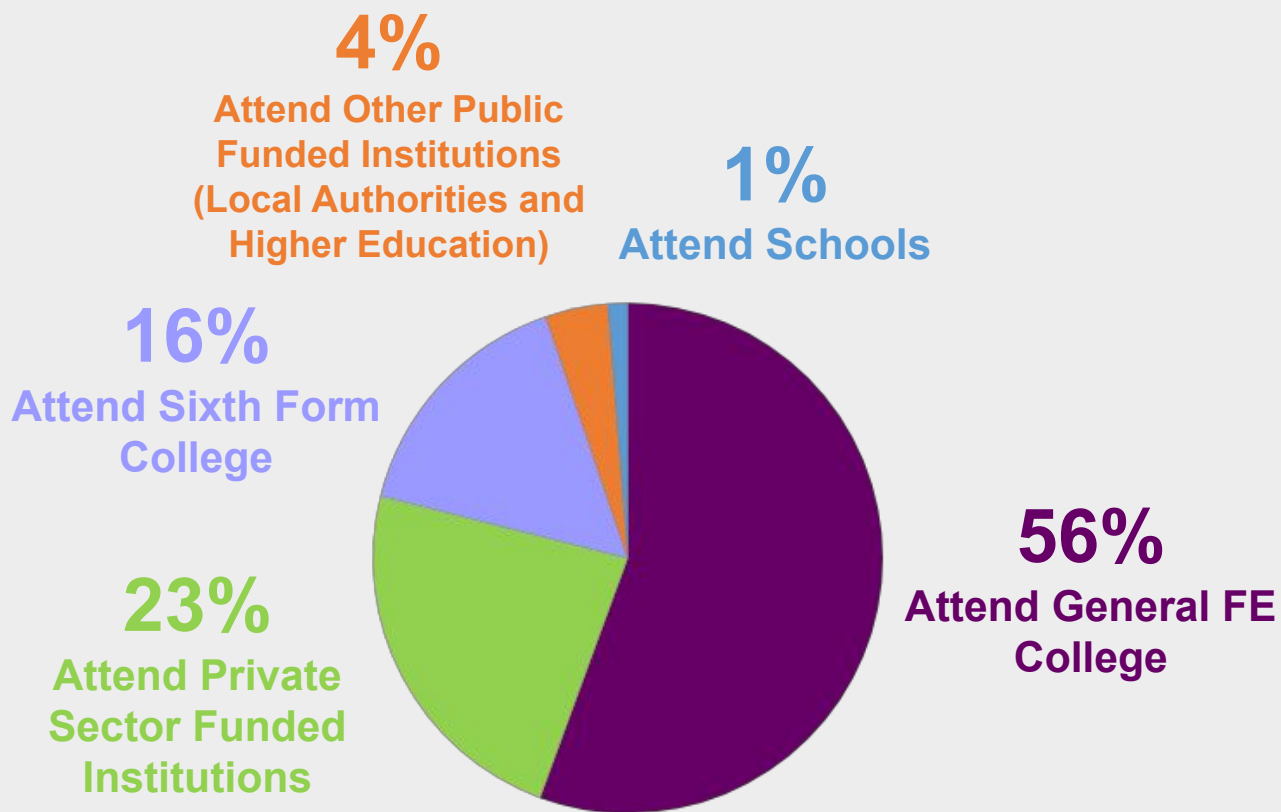


With cheaper house prices across your area, you will be able to save for a house quicker than other areas of England

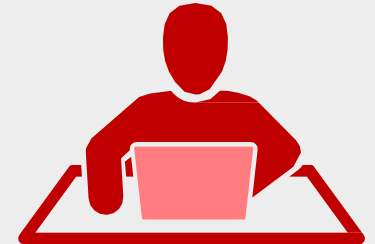

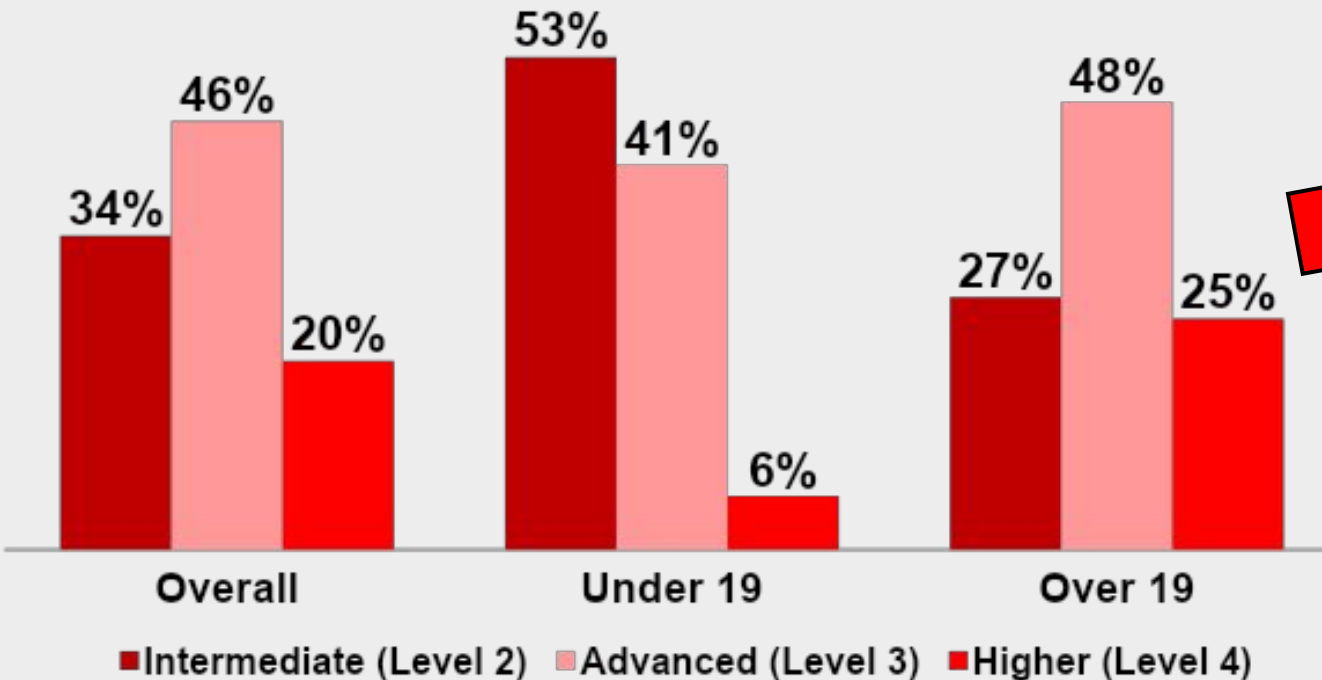
