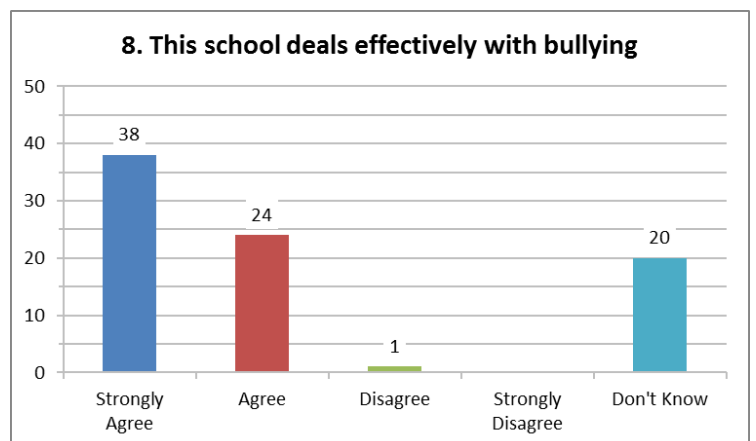
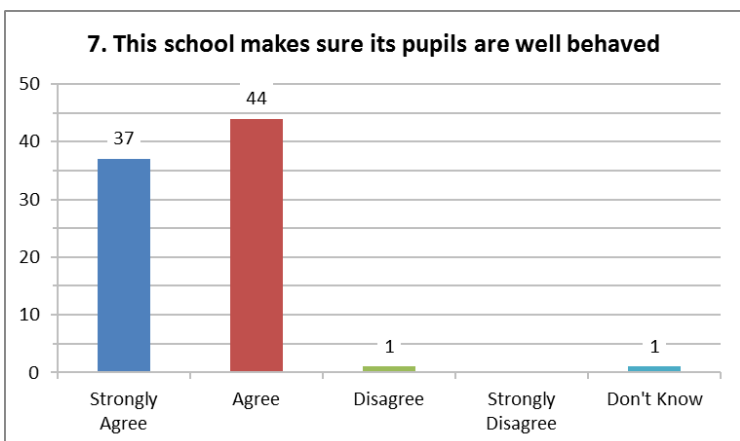
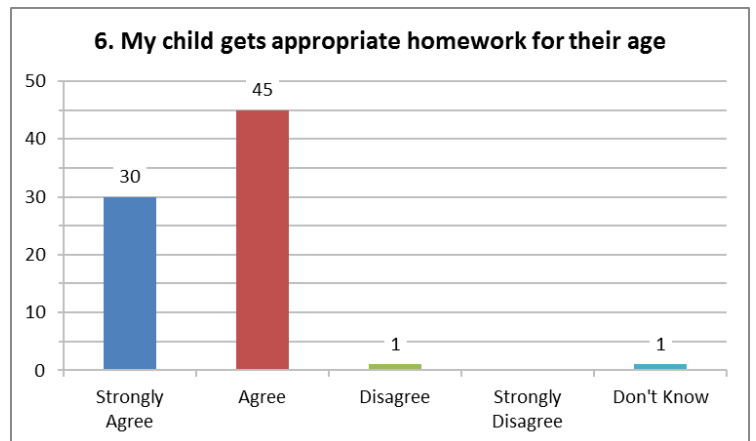
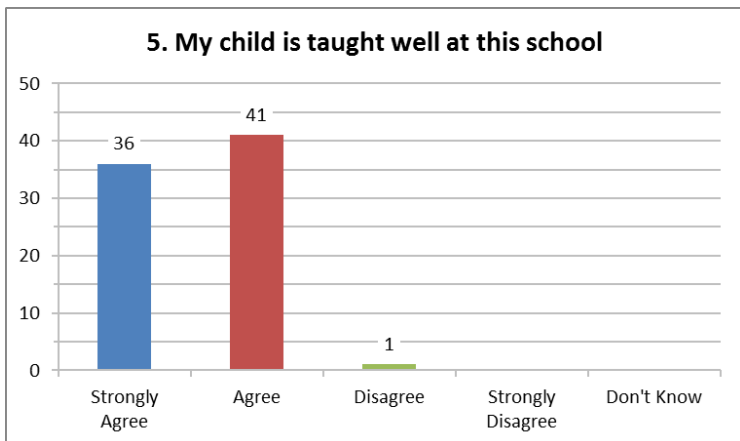
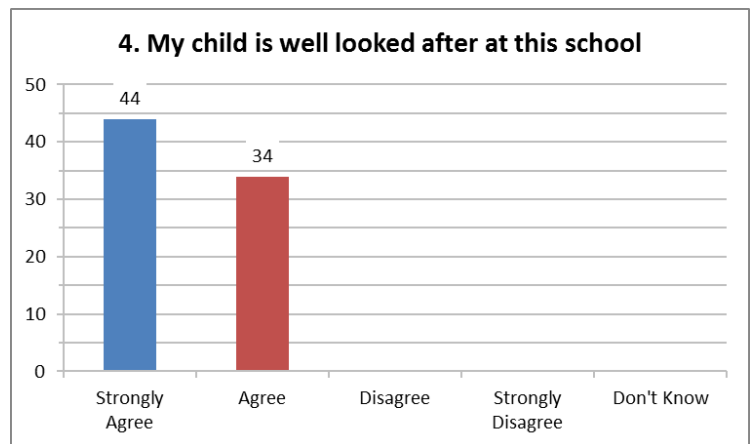
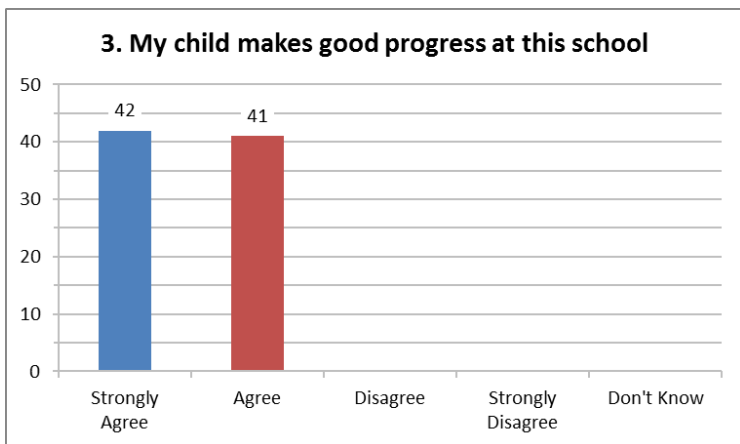
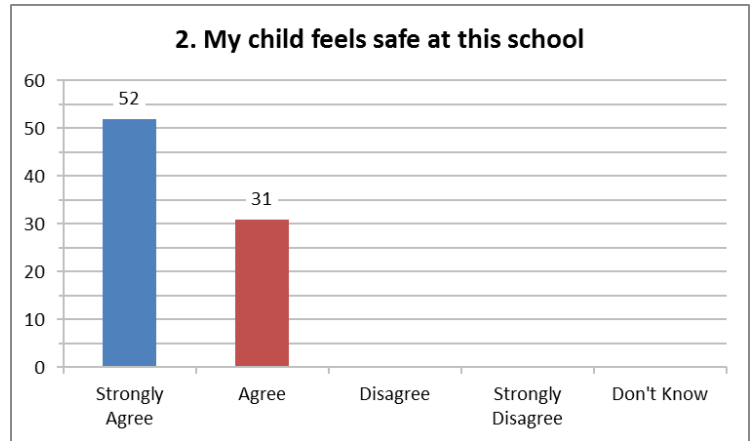
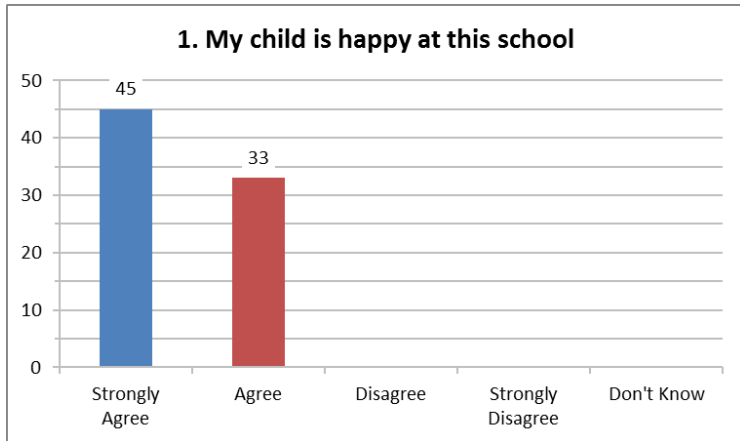
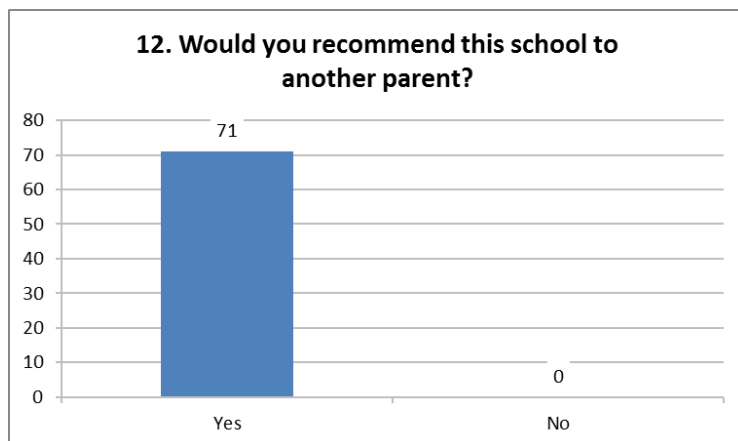
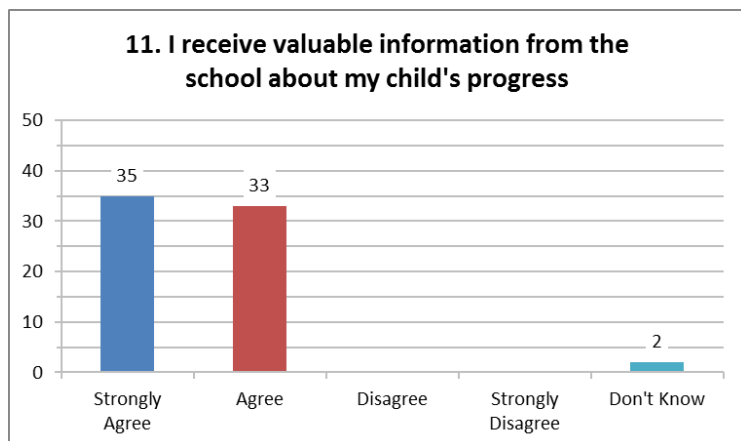
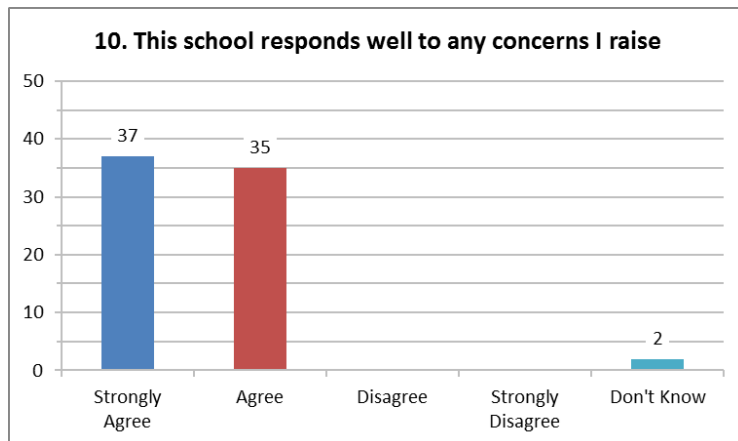
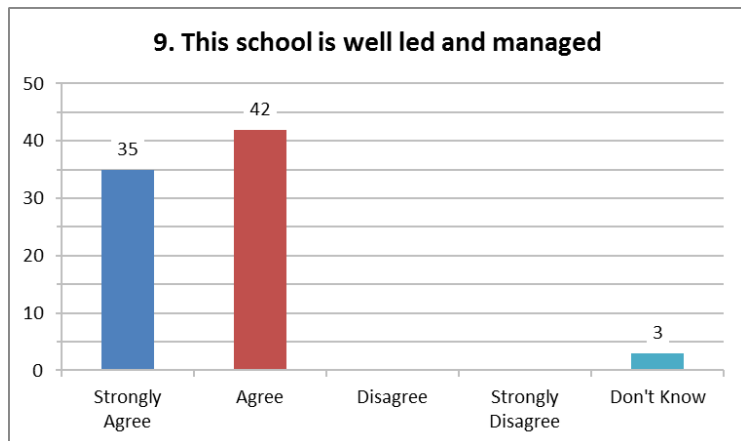


OFSTED PARENT VIEW QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS

Additional Comments:

- This is in our view an excellent school and has been for all 3 of our children. Some concerns about maths and science due to results in mocks. Our children (2 have left in the past 5 years) have all had a fantastic time, they have been safe and the school always communicated well with us.
- Parklands has really helped my child come out of her shell.
- Excellent school, a special thanks to Miss Burrell and Mr Marko.
- Extremely enjoyed it.
- Head listened when I asked for side gate into Astley Park to be opened. A great improvement.
- My daughter has enjoyed her time here. She is very motivated and has used this in her studies. I would recommend Parklands as a great High School.
- I am concerned that my son and all of his class achieved poor results in their mock in one particular subject area. He now has no desire to study it at A-level.
Response from school: This was a specific concern. We responded personally and addressed the issue.
- Chloe has thoroughly enjoyed her time at Parklands. She has had so many opportunities to get involved in all aspects of school life which is due to the fantastic ethos of the school
- Our son has flourished at Parklands after having a shaky start in Year 7. The final push towards his GCSE is our main focus now and all the teachers have been supportive throughout.
- Our daughter has settled in very quickly and has really enjoyed Parklands. She has progressed well and we are very happy with the school.
- The timer system at parent's evening clearly did not work. Yet another parent evening where times are not met.
Response from school: We trialled the timer system tonight and will continue to try and improve it.
- Real concerns with Chemistry as our daughter is saying she has to teach herself which is reflected in her mock result in a subject that our daughter feels is her strongest. This is of obvious concern to us as her current career choices involve chemistry. Disappointed with Science feedback at parents evening as they didn't seem to focus on our daughter as an individual. Our daughter has really enjoyed her time at Parklands and has learnt life skills she will carry through the rest of her education.

- I have concerns re the science department, in particular the number of staff changes our son has endured.
Response from school: Changes occurred due to maternity leave and a staff sabbatical.
- Not enough time, will write to the Head on conclusion of this school year.
- It should be possible to have the school info emailed to both parents. Both parents having access to on-line trackers etc. My daughter has done well at school and this is a credit to both parties. She has found the latter years more frustrating I think this is a combination of her age and a strong focus on exam results at the expense of a broader curriculum.
Response from school: We can ensure both parents receive all information relating to their child when advised to do so.
- Thank you! Our daughter has progressed well and has enjoyed every year here at Parklands.
- The school constantly informs parents of children's progress. The school website is easy to access.
- Our daughter has enjoyed her time at Parklands, has been taught well and has benefited from the wider school community and responsibilities she has been given. The teaching staff appear very competent and our daughter's results appear to reflect this.
