For anyone who finds the idea of a large college a little bit overwhelming, don't forget there are options to study at local sixth forms, where class sizes (and overall student numbers) are much smaller - for example, Rivington & Blackrod 6th Form.

At RBHS you can take a combination of BTECs and A Levels: 3 A levels; 2 A levels and a BTEC Certificate (equal to 1 A Level); 1 A Level and a BTEC Diploma (equal to 2 A Levels) or a BTEC Extended Diploma (equal to 3 A Levels). They offer a huge range of subjects so it might be worth checking out the website https://www.rbhs.co.uk/ or see Miss Berry for a prospectus.




