## Y11 GCSE Mock Examination Results

On Tuesday 14th Jan pupils in Year 11 will receive their mock examination results. This will take place in the hall during registration. They will also meet with their house achievement leaders and receive their trackers during the course of the day. We appreciate your support in the build up to the summer exams, please take a moment to review these results with your child and consider how they would feel if these were their actual GCSE results.

Year 11 students had an assembly from NCS - National Citizen Service - on Thursday.
