## **Principal's Message**

It has been fantastic to welcome our pupils back this week, including our brand new Year 7 cohort. I have been really pleased with how well the Year 7s have settled in, and also with how helpful our older pupils have been; I have seen lots of new Year 7s being taken to their lessons by smiling Year 11s! I have been really impressed with how smart all of our pupils look and it is excellent to see the whole school community looking very smart. We feel that it is really important to establish high standards of presentation and uniform from the start of the school year; wearing our uniform with pride is one of the things that brings us together as a community.

This year we are going to work hard to ensure that we recognise and reward excellent attitude both inside and outside of the classroom, hard work, and behaviour for learning. We already have a reward system, but we feel that we can do more to recognise the everyday positive behaviours of our pupils. Look out for Mrs Wilkinson's notifications about Class Charts, which is one of the ways that we will be recognising our pupils' achievements.

A few of you have asked for clarification about some changes that we have made. As a school we take the environment and Global Warming seriously, and we encourage our pupils to be responsible global citizens. It is for this reason, and also in response to the canvassing of our School Food Champions, that we have decided to no longer sell single use plastic water bottles. Thank you for your support in sending your children with reusable water bottles, which can be filled at one of our water fountains.

We understand that some of you are concerned about the 30 minute lunch. Change can sometimes be unsettling for pupils, but we believe that this is a positive move for our school. We monitored the time that it took for pupils to buy and eat their lunch before the summer, and it was clear that half an hour would be plenty of time and would give us extra learning time. The Government set required time in lessons last year, and this equated to an extra 10 minutes for Parklands. We consulted with staff and parents; the preference was for a shorter lunch, rather than a later finish of 3.10pm. In preparation for this, we have invested heavily in an upgraded Refectory and additional serving area. We have also bought new tables to allow pupils to sit and eat their lunch in a calmer environment. Please see the picture on the next page of our new Refectory area. We will continue to monitor the arrangements.

In order to support our year 7s with the transition, we are also starting lunch for them 15 minutes early, and we will continue this through next week. This means that the Year 7s currently have 45 minutes for lunch whilst they get used to the arrangements, which is allowing them plenty of time to eat, visit the toilet, and socialise with their friends<del>.</del>
