Principal's Message

Dear parents, carers, and students

We have had another busy week at Parklands. On Monday Ms Gray and Miss Pilkington took a group of students to the LGBTQ Youth Summit in Manchester, where they had the opportunity to listen to a variety of speakers and take part in activities with over 350 children from around the country. Miss Brooks and Ms Alston took a group of Year 9 students to the Physics Olympics, and they returned with several medals! We also held our first SEND Progress evening and welcomed lots of parents and carers to meet with members of the Learning Support Department. This was a great success and will be repeated each term. Today we have children in from Gillibrand Primary who are getting to try out their skills in the D&T department. Mr Cunningham and the Learning Support Team have also taken a group of students to Wild Discoveries at Ribby Hall, where they are hoping to see an alligator!

I would also like to thank you all for assisting us in upholding uniform standards during this period of unpredictable weather. We hope that the change to PE kit has helped your children to be more comfortable over the last few weeks.

As next week is an unusual week, I would just like to remind you of the arrangements for pupils.

Monday 3rd July is INSET day, so school will be closed to all pupils.

Tuesday 4th July is a normal school day for all pupils. Pupils should wear full PE kit or school uniform.

Wednesday 5th July is a strike day, as well as induction day for Year 6 pupils. School will be closed to all year groups apart from Year 7, who will be in school.

- Year 7 should wear full PE kit or school uniform. They should arrive for 8.55am and they will be in school until 2pm.
- Year 10 are attending the Runshaw College Taster Day. pupils should arrive at school for 8.45am and should wear full school uniform (not PE kit).

Thursday 6th July is a normal school day for all pupils. Pupils should wear full PE kit or school uniform.

Friday 7th July is a strike day. School will be closed to all pupils, unless arrangements have already been made for more vulnerable pupils.

We hope that you understand we have not taken the decision lightly to close either partially or fully We made the decision to secure the health and safety of your child and any non-striking staff in consideration of anticipated heavily reduced numbers of staffing

Then it was the 9-10's turn and they had a great afternoon and the final ended up on penalties between us and St Michaels. We won and took the rather large trophy back to Parklands!







Opportunity for your child to participate in NHS research and make a difference! A research Orthoptist at Lancashire Teaching Hospitals is completing a visual field study at the Lancashire Eye Centre, Chorley Hospital and is looking for recruits over the summer holidays!

KINETIC2 Study

The research is to establish visual field normal values in children. There is currently no option other than to compare a child's visual field result to that of an adult result. A child's visual field does not reach adult levels until about the age of 12-15 years, therefore, it is not ideal to compare a child's visual field result to an adult's visual field. This study will collect visual field assessment results from a range of children who have normal visual field function. The information will be used to create a normal database for children aged 5-17 years old. This will allow future comparison of children's visual field results to an appropriate age-matched result.


