Headteacher's message

Dear parents, carers and students,

As you will be aware, on the 10th May the Department for Education updated its guidance to state that "From 17th May, in line with Step 3 of the roadmap, face coverings will no longer be recommended for pupils in classrooms or communal areas in all schools". We shall therefore continue follow the government guidance and remove the need to wear face coverings, but there may be occasions when staff request pupils wear a mask, such as when needing to work closely with someone. Please also be advised that some staff may continue to wear face coverings. It is also worth noting that local restrictions may change due to the Indian variant and it cannot be ruled out that we will be advised to reimpose the requirement to wear face coverings again.

Furthermore, the guidance continues to say that, "children and young people aged 11 and over **must** still wear a face covering on public transport. In accordance with advice from PHE, they **must** also wear a face covering when travelling on dedicated transport to secondary school or college. This does not apply to children and young people who are exempt from wearing face coverings".
