Headteacher's message

Dear parents and carers and students,

URGENT UPDATE

We were contacted around 2.15pm by Lancashire County Council Public Health Team with regards to our active Covid 19 cases.

They have advised that, unfortunately, our isolating Year 11 cases must extend their isolation date to midnight of 25th May and will therefore only be unable to return to school on Wednesday 26th May.

They have also advised that all isolating students and household members must get a PCR test from a local test centre as soon as possible. Tests can be booked online using the 'my council has asked me to test' section.

All results must be reported to school. Please note that a negative result DOES NOT end any isolation period. The full 10 days must be completed.

Public Health also stipulated that from Monday 24th May all sickness absences, regardless of symptoms, will need a PCR test completing before returning to school. This is a local government directive, <u>not a Parklands initiative</u>.

Public Health have advised that the new variant is very prominent in the Lancashire area and is showing very different symptoms to previous variants. The vaccination program is now open to anyone aged over 34 years and they strongly advise that people take this opportunity to get one.

I have emailed all year 11s and parents/carers regarding next week. Please ensure you read the information carefully and join the Google Meet at 8.40am if you are at all unclear. I know the changes we have had to implement are very sudden, but please rest assured that none of this will have a negative impact on your GCSE grades. We will take all these circumstances into account so that no-one is penalised or disadvantaged due to the current situation.

SAFEGUARDING: ONLINE SAFETY

Dear parents and carers,

It has been brought to our attention from the police that the safety of some of our students has been seriously put at risk due to adult males infiltrating social media sites such as Snap-Chat, Instagram, Tik Tok and Facebook. Images of a sexual nature have been sent to our students and invites for students to send explicit photos of themselves have been encouraged. This has opened up investigations spread across the country. Please can I advise that these social sites are monitored closely by yourselves and that you check on your son/daughter's content regularly and know who they are conversing with. Advice is that students should be thirteen years and over to access them should be regarded.Please also encourage your son/daughter to speak to you should strangers send them requests which they know are inappropriate and report to the police straight away.
