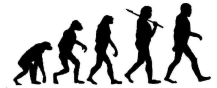

Finally, year 9 and year 10 both had respect days this week, where visitors from outside the school came to talk to them about safety and life in crime.

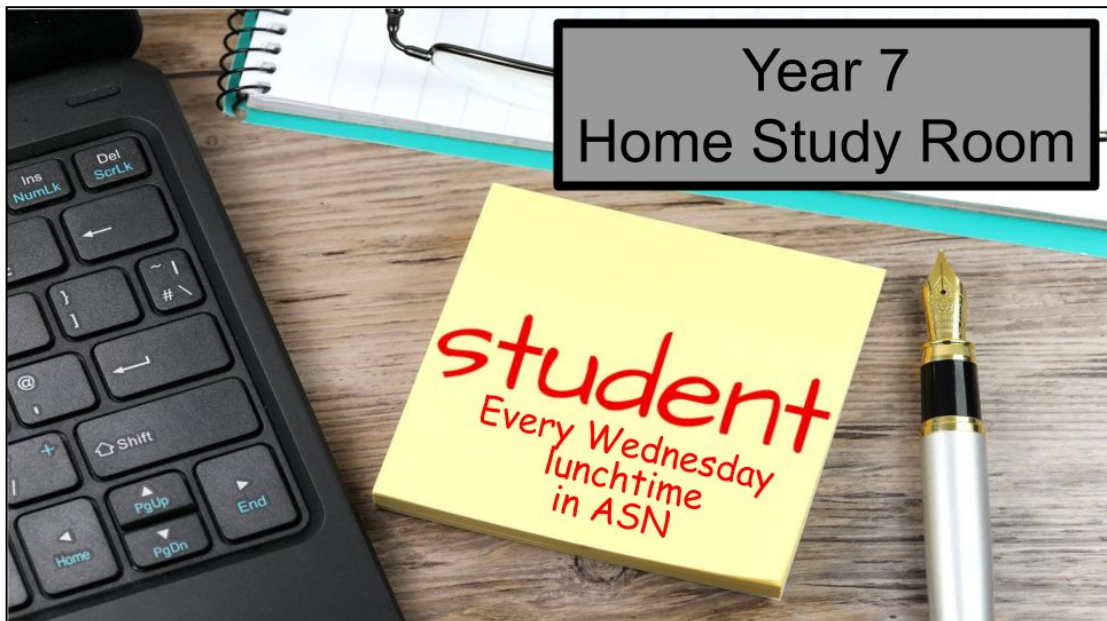
