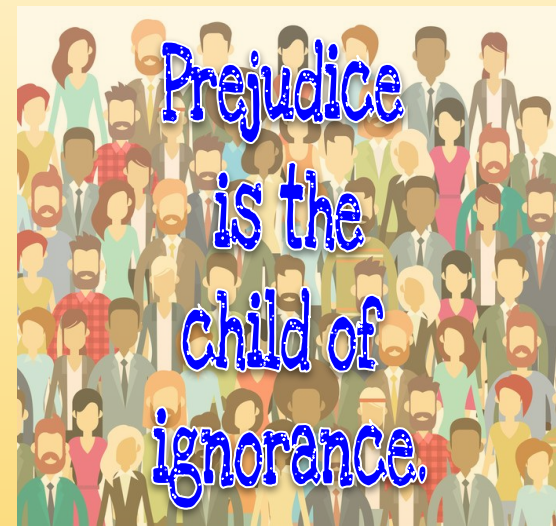

## Historical Fact of the Week

On this day in **1931...**  
**AL CAPONE CONVICTED OF TAX EVASION**  
**Sentenced to 11 years in Federal Prison**

Alphonse Capone was born in New York in 1899 and grew up as a part of the Five Points gang. This criminal enterprise of Italian-Americans in Manhattan also produced well-known mobsters like Charlie "Lucky" Luciano and Johnny Torrio.

Torrio moved to Chicago in 1909 to work for crime boss "Big Jim" Colosimo. Colosimo operated hundreds of brothels and gambling rackets, but refused to go into bootlegging. The 18th Amendment in 1920 had prohibited the making or selling alcohol. This was a huge growth opportunity for organized crime groups. In 1920 Torrio asked Capone to join them in Chicago. Colosimo was soon shot dead. Nobody was ever arrested for the murder but many believe that Torrio ordered the hit and Capone was involved in the killing.

In 1925, Johnny Torrio was shot by a rival gang and then sent to prison for operating an illegal distillery. He resigned as Boss of the crime gang and moved back to Italy. With Torrio gone, Capone took control of the so-called 'Outfit'. From 1925 through 1929, Capone was the most-visible mobster in America.

Escalating Mob violence in Chicago culminated in the St. Valentine's Day Massacre on 14th February 1929. Seven associates of the Bugs Moran gang – rivals of Capone – were lined up against the wall of a garage by men posing as police officers and machine-gunned to death. Although Capone was on vacation in Florida at the time and never arrested for the crime, he was widely suspected of ordering the massacre.

By this time the U.S. Treasury's Special Intelligence Unit was compiling a tax evasion case against him. They did not have to prove that Capone was a mobster, simply that he wasn't paying taxes on his income. It was clear that Capone had to have substantial income to support his lavish lifestyle. On 18th October 1931, he was sentenced to 11 years in federal prison. Capone was released from Alcatraz prison in 1939. His mental and physical health was now poor and he died eight years later, aged just forty-eight.


