#### Headteacher's Message

Dear parents, carers and students,

This afternoon we attended a meeting with Public Health Lancashire regarding the significant increase in positive cases amongst our students, especially amongst Year 11. The advice given was as follows:

- Year 11 parents/carers will receive a separate communication from Mrs Fish.
- Daily lateral flow testing for all students should continue until further notice. This is due to the volume of positive cases in all schools being at its highest ever, but thankfully it is not being reflected in the number of hospitalisations thanks to the vaccine programme.
- Infection control measures in school continue.
- Face coverings remain strongly recommended. Please ensure your child attends school with a face covering to help prevent further outbreaks.

If we can all support one another, this will hopefully prevent any possible closures of year groups and reverting to online teaching.

2. Show yourself off

3. Proofread

It's really important to be professional in your application and spelling, grammar and punctuation mistakes should always be avoided! Make sure you re-read it a few times, or get someone else to, so you can ensure there are no errors.

4. Ideas for the school

We're always looking for ways to improve the school, so make sure you mention some good ideas you have to make Parklands a better place. This is especially for those applying for SSLT

5. Put yourself out there

Even if you're not sure if you're qualified for a senior role in school, please still apply and give it a go! You never know what will happen and even if you don't manage to get a role or become prefect, it gives you great experience for the future.

6. Help and advice

If you have any friends who are prefects or a member of our SSLT, or there's someone in your form who is, then you can ask them for help, or to proofread your application. We are also more than happy to help, if you see us around school and want some advice, or to read over your application, please ask!

#### PGL WATERSPORTS NOTICE

I am extremely disappointed to report that due to ongoing COVID restrictions for international group travel, PGL have taken the difficult but unavoidable decision not to operate their centres in southern France in 2022.

This means we cannot run the Overseas France Watersports trip 2022..

However, I am pleased to say PGL has offered an alternative that I think will still provide great enjoyment and experiences to our pupils. I have attached the PGL leaflet in this email.

The dates for this trip are Sunday 7th August - Friday 12th August 2022

This trip will come at a reduced cost of £635.

The offer I have is for us to attend the Jurassic Coast, at PGL Osmington Bay, Dorset. It is a beautiful coastal location with stunning views with direct access to the beach. It has everything to offer our thrill seekers from coasteering and a visit to a giant inflatable park. The children will still take part in various sailing activities including, dinghies, catamarans and sea kayaks. They will take part in cliff jumps, explore sea caves, climbing and axe throwing. We also have evening entertainment and day trips to Weymouth and Bournemouth. This all coincides with the typical PGL adventurous activities.
