Dear parents, carers and students,

Covid19 Testing: On the 4th January 2022 pupils with parental consent will be taking a Covid19 lateral flow test during their form time. Due to Government updated guidance previous consent will not be used. Therefore we would appreciate it if you could complete the consent form which is available in the forms section of Edulink to allow your child to participate and help us to keep our school community as safe as possible. If you have difficulties logging into Edulink please email adowsing@parklandsacademy.co.uk and he will be able to assist you. Please note: the testing is for 12 years and over only. If your child has been Covid19 positive in the 90 days leading up to the 4th January they should not take part in the testing.

The cut off date for your completed consent form in Edulink is Thursday 9th December.

#### **UK PGL WATERSPORTS HOLIDAY 2022**

You may or may not be aware but due to the current situation the France Watersports Holiday for 2022 has had to be cancelled.

However, I am pleased to say PGL has offered an alternative that I think will still provide great enjoyment and experiences to our pupils. I have attached the PGL leaflet in this email.

The dates for this trip are Sunday 7th August - Friday 12th August 2022. This trip will come at a reduced cost of £635.

The offer I have is for us to attend the Jurassic Coast, at PGL Osmington Bay, Dorset. It is a beautiful coastal location with stunning views with direct access to the beach. It has everything to offer our thrill seekers from coasteering and a visit to a giant inflatable park. The children will still take part in various sailing activities including, dinghies, catamarans and sea kayaks. They will take part in exploring sea caves, climbing and axe throwing. We also have evening entertainment and day trips to Weymouth and Bournemouth. This all coincides with the typical PGL adventurous activities.

Food and accommodation is all still included. As we have cancelled the overseas holiday I now have spaces for pupils to join this trip. I have included a leaflet <a href="here">here</a> but please note PGL are giving us an extra night/day as we have had to cancel the overseas trip with extra activities..

If you wish for your child to attend this trip, please pay the deposit on SCOPAY 'NG 2022 UK WATERSPORTS', for your child to be secured a place on the new UK trip. A deposit of £100 is required.
