

First /Occasional
Teacher deals with it & issues appropriate sanction. Information logged on SIMs via BFL indicators which are reviewed daily by CL's and HALs

Minor-
Staff deal with concern and issue a social strike, if applicable*. Record on SIMs and on Social Strikes spread sheet, if applicable.

Major-
Staff refer to HALs / SLT who will then deal with it. Social strike issued if applicable

SLT behaviour review meetings
SLT will meet weekly to monitor/discuss and meet with individuals. Strike system will apply linked to reward trips and School Prom

*** REASONS FOR ISSUING SOCIAL STRIKE:**
Pupils In out of bounds areas, Swearing, Littering, Play fighting,
Eating outside of designated areas, Anti-social behaviour, Name calling, Tie stealing, Refusal to follow reasonable requests, Taking down, Ball stealing
Sanctions
3 social strikes will incur 3 x lunchtime detentions, every subsequent social strike will incur 3 more.
