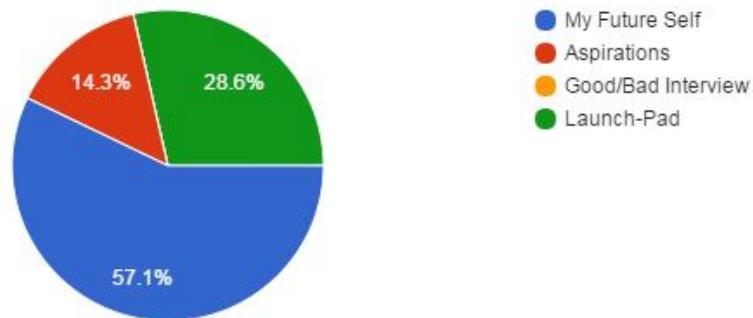


Year 7 Respect (CEIAG) Staff feedback 2018

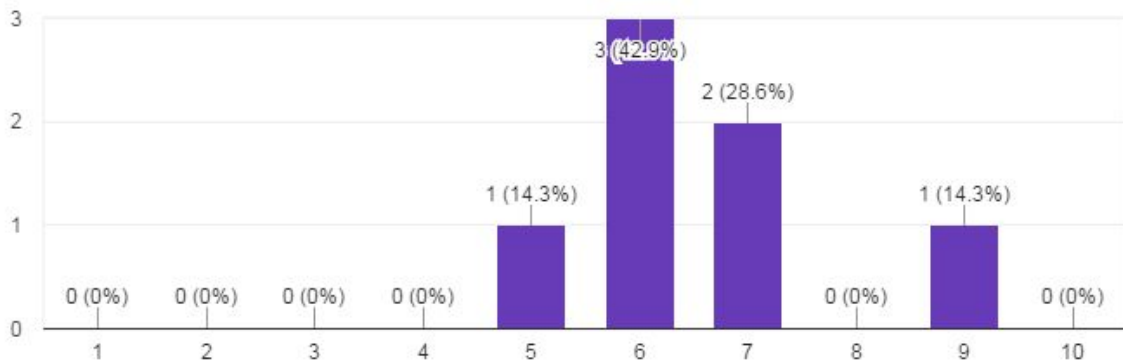
Which session were you supporting?

- The letter writing task was really good but most pupils finished early. I think an extra activity lasting 10 minutes could improve the session.
