

## KS2







## Turkey burgers recipe



### **Ingredients**

450g minced turkey
1 small onion, very finely chopped
1 carrot, grated
50g sweetcorn
2 teaspoons dried mixed herbs
1 pinch ground black pepper
4 standard burger buns, cut in half
2 handfuls lettuce leaves
8 tomato slices



### **Method**

- 1. Preheat the grill to a medium-high heat. Put the turkey meat, onion, carrot, sweetcorn and herbs into a large bowl. Season with some pepper and mix together you can do this with your hands if you like.
- 2. Grill the burgers for 12 to 15 minutes, turning them over once, until browned and cooked through. Remove from the grill and let rest for a couple of minutes.
- 3. While the cooked burgers are cooling, lightly toast the burger buns under the grill on the cut side only.
  - 4. Put some lettuce on the bottom halves and place the burgers on top.
- 5. Add 2 slices of tomato onto each one and cover with the top half of the bun.
