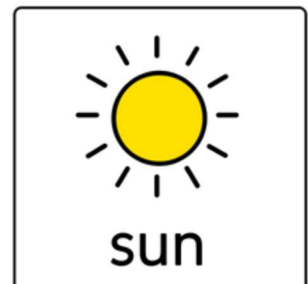
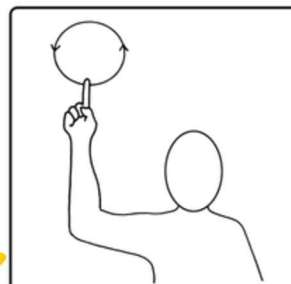

KS1

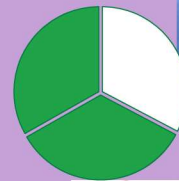

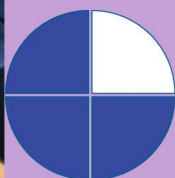
KS2
