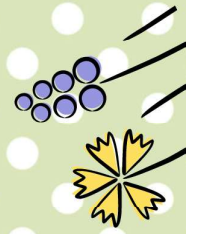

In computing we are learning about directions and using the bee bots to create our own track for them to follow.

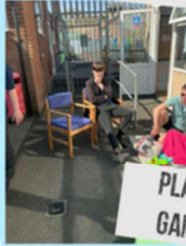
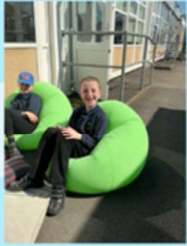
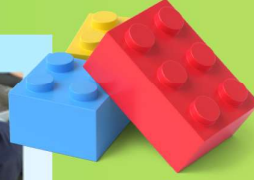
