Toffee Popcorn Recipe



Ingredients

30ml Oil
100g Popping corn
50g Butter
50g Soft brown sugar
75g Golden Syrup

<u>Method</u>

Heat oil in a saucepan, add the corn with the lid on. Shake coat all corn into the oil

Shake occasionally until corn has popped. Remove from heat.

Place butterm sugar and syrup into another pan. Stir until the butter has melted and sugar has dissolved.

Put the pop corn into a large mixing bowl. Drizzle the toffee sauce over the top.

Stir until the popcorn is coated.

Leave to cool & enjoy!
