## 3C's – Communication, Confidence and Creativity

Ensemble: Working as part of a group developing essential team work skills.

Devising: Developing own ideas from scratch or using a basic stimulus.

Body Language & Facial Expressions: Understanding the importance of non-verbal communication.

Projection and Articulation: Developing essential skills within communication.
