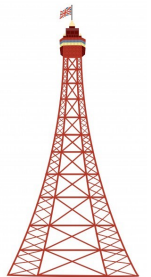
How can we save energy at school and at home? Taking care of our school environment. Litter issues. Healthy living and sustainability.
