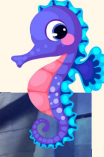

1H had a fantastic trip to the Sealife Centre this week. All of the children were beautifully behaved and loved exploring and seeing all the different sea creatures.

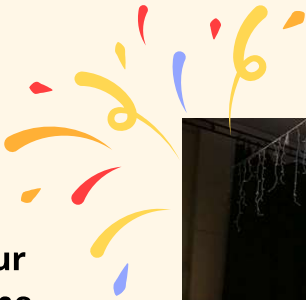


KS2

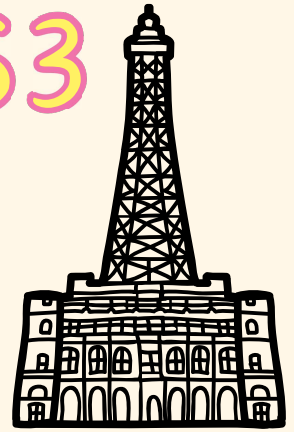
Good luck to all Year 6. You will have a fantastic time in Year 7.

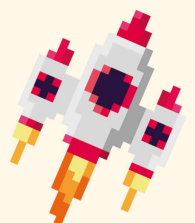


In our Art lesson this week 4S have been working on our fine motor skills. We made modeling clay to make ice cream sculptures. Well Done 4S
