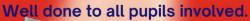

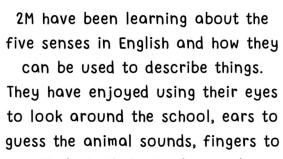

## Pizza crumpets recipe

## Ingredients

4 crumpets

4 tablespoons tomato purée 4 tomatoes, sliced

2 teaspoons dried mixed herbs 40g reduced-fat hard cheese, grated 1 pinch of ground black pepper

#### Method

Preheat the grill. Toast the undersides of the crumpets until crispy - about 2 minutes.

Remove from the grill, flip the crumpets over and spread each with 1 teaspoon of tomato purée. Arrange the sliced tomatoes on top and grill for 2 minutes.

Sprinkle the herbs and cheese evenly over the crumpets, season with pepper to taste, and grill until the cheese melts and bubbles - another minute or so. Serve at once.

#### Information:

Add a little chopped cooked ham, chopped cooked chicken or extra vegetables, such as sliced peppers, courgette or mushrooms on the crumpets before sprinkling with the cheese.

Try using wholemeal pitta breads as a change from crumpets. Just skip grilling the underside.
