

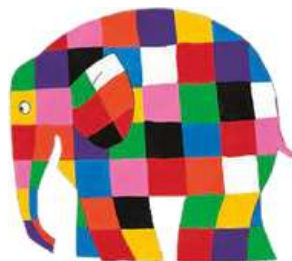

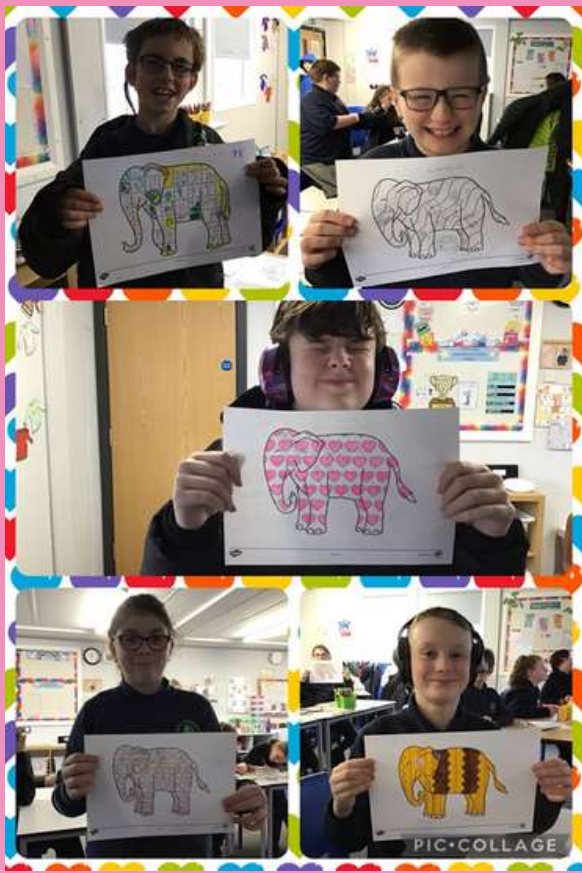
KS2
