Congratulations to Mrs Bickerstaffe our Finance Lead, who became Mayor of Medlar with Wesham for 24-25 this week.

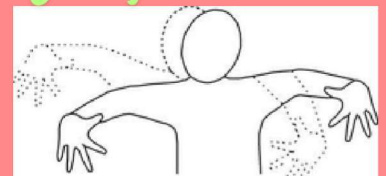
Congratulations to class 4S for 100% attendance this week. Whole school attendance is 91.2%

2M - Jacob for his fantastic help during bucket time.

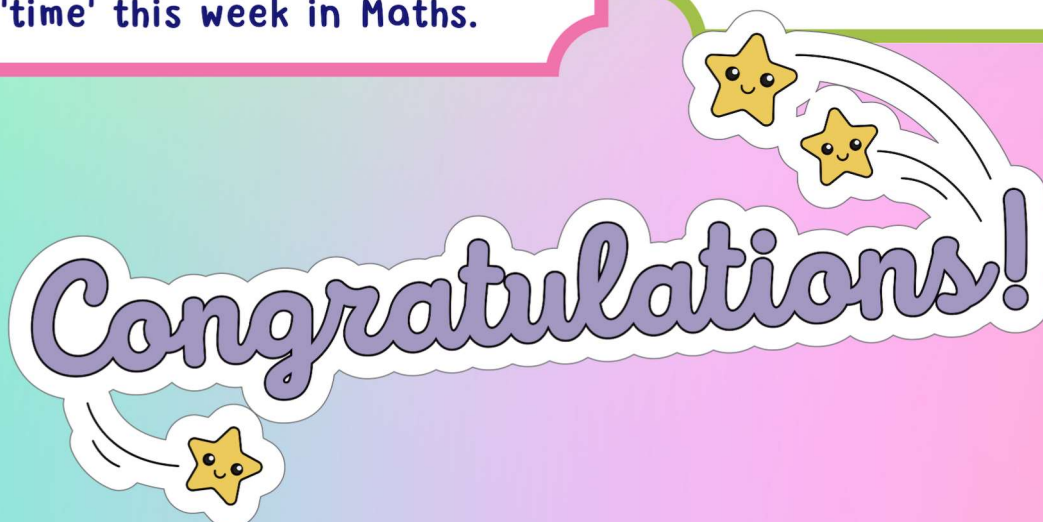
2B - Lorenzo for trying hard at swimming.

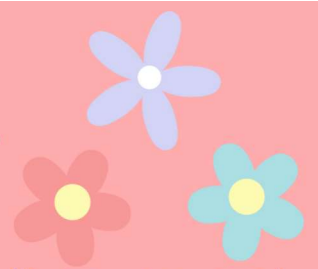


KS3

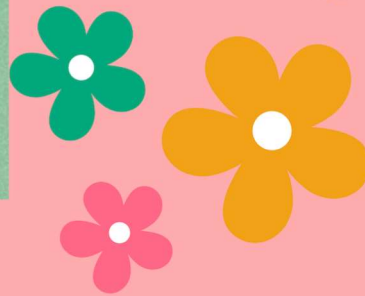
