WJEC Entry Level Humanities

Pupils in Key Stage 4 work towards an Entry Level qualification in Humanities. In order to provide some differentiation, all Humanities units are offered at Entry 2 level and Entry 3 level - pupils will be entered for the most appropriate Level. The learning outcomes are the same for each, but the assessment criteria are more challenging at Entry 3. As part of this qualification they have a dedicated Humanities lesson each week.
