Update of Medical Info (OS3) / Contact Details



<u>'Teachers2Parents' App</u> - We regularly send out text messages to parents/carers from school on the 'Teachers2Parents' app. This can be downloaded via the App store / Play store for android phones. Just search 'Teachers2Parents' and it will link to your mobile number. It will then automatically show Park and any other school that you share your mobile number with.

<u>Use of Physical Control</u> - Staff at Park Community Academy have undertaken a nationally recognised training programme in the positive management of child aggression and disruption. This includes a variety of ways of calming down difficult situations. However when a child has lost self control, staff will manage the situation using <u>safe</u> physical control methods designed specifically for children. Such control is carried out within a legal framework agreed with the Department for Education and the Local Education Authority.

Academy Uniform - If you have ordered new Academy uniform and not yet collected it, please do so before the end of next week or it will need to be put back into stock. PLEASE REMEMBER TO LABEL ALL ITEMS OF UNIFORM WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME. Should you experience any problems with payment, please contact school to discuss - we are always here to help.
