- WSFC offers placements up till the age of 19. Our pathways are designed to prepare students for their next steps and the duration of each pathway is flexible.
- All students across the 6<sup>th</sup> form will complete internal and external work experience placements throughout the year – pupils are placed at their preferred destination supported and unsupported.
- All students have the option block once a week, students chose from – Art, Dance, Choir/Band or Duke of Edinburgh Silver Award.
- All students attend college on a Tuesday or Thursday at Myerscough College or Blackpool & Fylde College / Gateway
- All Year 14 students will follow a specialised Enterprise curriculum one day per week in preparation for their next steps
- All Year 12 pupils will complete the National Citizenship Award
