


A fun phonics game for you to try at home.



What to do:

- Start by saying 'I walked down the street and I saw a/heard a...... 1)
- 2) Then sound out what you saw or heard eq. c-a-t



- 3) Ask your child to say the sound to go with the word you have just sounded out. Eg. Meeeowww
- 4) Then ask your child what was it you saw.
- 5) Your child responds with the name of the object/ animal that you have just seen/ sounded out.

To make it more of a challenge

Make the sounds more complex by using blends-bl, br, ch, ck, cl, cr, dr, fl, fr, gh, gl, gr, ng, ph, pl, pr, qu, sc, sh, sk, sl, sm, sn, sp, st, sw, th, tr, tw, wh, wr

This is a great game very similar to eye spy that could be played whilst exploring your garden, taking a walk around your local area or within your home. You can use CVC words or use blends to make it more challenging. This game provides lots of great opportunities for your child to develop their memory skills, listen to letter sounds and blend them to make wor
