


## KS3 assessment in French



Lesson 1 - Pupils receive a visual roadmap of the Key Stage 3 They also receive a **Language guide. E**ach guide provides succinct grammar explanations, vocabulary lists, and a phonics guide to support students' independent learning for the first and second term of Year 8 of French.



### Assessment of Phonics

Phonics are assessed regularly each lesson. We use a variety of techniques:

- Vocaroo based homework
- Gamification/deliberate practice
- Repetition
- Read aloud tasks
- Reading in pairs
- Online resources for phonics (Language Nut)
- 1:1 mini in class teacher assessments
- Teacher observation





# Summative assessment

- Pupils complete a paperbased assessment 3 times throughout the year.
- The results are used to support the pupil when returning to and completing the PLC for vocabulary and grammar
- These assessments largely assess vocabulary and grammar
