

Year Group	Activity	Outcome
All	Careers Board	Science have a careers board in our subject area.
All	Career's Week 2 nd to 7 th March 2020	All subjects will participate in the National Careers Week. Subjects will be expected to deliver CEIAG information related to their subject in every lesson during the week.
All	Science specific careers fair (September 2019)	Pupils of all years (with the exception of 3 groups) attended a science specific careers fair. Local colleges, universities, employees (e.g. Leyland Trucks, Rosmere Cancer Centre, Forensic department Lancashire police, Nuffield Health) attended and spoke to pupils about career opportunities within science subjects. The aim was to expose pupils to the vast variety of careers available within the sciences.
All	Engineer Research UCLAN	A mix of pupils will be completing a questionnaire as part of a research project set out at UCLAN to gauge interest in a career in Engineering. Feedback will be presented to pupils.
All	Science and Engineering Week (March 2020)	During this week activities will take place to encourage participation in the STEM subjects.
Year 7	STEM club	To encourage pupils to make links between Maths, Science and Technology. Pupils who take part undertake a number of projects to raise awareness of innovations and careers within STEM. We plan to take STEM pupils on a trip to a local power station to provide them with an opportunity to see how it operates and the types of jobs available.
Year 8	STEM event – Runshaw College (March 2020)	Pupils will be given an introduction to the science of renewable energy/hybrid vehicle technologies.
Year 9	MOSI – Royal Institute Christmas Lecture (Dec 2019)	For pupils to have the experience of being part of the well-established Christmas Lectures. To be challenged by the content and gather an understanding of how Maths and Science link together and the possible opportunities they can offer.
Year 10	UCLAN visit (May 2020)	For pupils to visit university setting and be part of a research project. Pupils will carry out one of the Physics Required Practical's in a university lab.

Year 11	Outside speakers – Engineering & Ecology	A small group of year 11 pupils were presented to by an Ecologist and Engineer. The aim was to inform pupils about career opportunities but also make them aware of the variety of routes there are into careers in science.
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
