All	English careers posters	Poster and guidance in each classroom for careers linking to English from the Careers and Enterprise Company.
	Poetry competition (Elizabeth Burns Children's Poetry Prize)	All pupils will be invited to enter competition where pupils are to write poems on justice, peace, history, or nature under threat.
	National Apprenticeship Week	Amazing Apprenticeships in English poster displayed in all classrooms to broaden pupils' understanding of English-based apprenticeships.
	Librarians	Pupils across all year group are eligible to apply for the role of a librarian. They will help to coordinate the smooth running of our in-school library.
7	Delivered in class - Explore careers in theatre/acting	Pupils will explore the requirements of working in theatre/writing scripts/being an actor as part of their introduction to Shakespeare.
