| Year Group | Activity | Outcome |
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| All | Careers Board | This is in development, and a collaboration between History, Geography and RE. Until this is in position, posters are displayed within the Humanities building and in classrooms. |
| All | Career's Week | All subjects will participate in the National Careers Week. Subjects will be expected to deliver CEIAG information related to their subject in every lesson during the week. |
| All | Careers PowerPoint Slides | At the beginning of each new topic, a career focus linked to the theme about to be taught is explored with students. Students learn about the qualifications needed for the career, the average salary and what the job involves. The students then watch a video diary about a day in the life of a worker in that profession. |
| Year 8 | Bowness, Lake District Visit | Pupils are spoken to by staff about potential careers in town planning and tourism whilst on the trip. The boat guide often gives a history of how they came to be a tour guide in The Lake District. |
| Year 9 | River Study Visit | Pupils are taken to a river to carry out fieldwork. Within this visit we discuss careers in engineering, hydrology and flood management. |
| Year 10 | Liverpool Urban Visit | Those who continue to study Geography at KS4 explore how and why urban spaces have changed and the struggles town planners and developers have to ensure sustainability. On the visit we talk about careers in town planning, urban development and sustainable development. |
| Year 11 | Urban Planning | Speakers are being invited in as a new initiative in 2024 to speak to students about their role in local urban management. This will compliment the STEAM focus of the school. Two speakers will be attending workshops in Geography: Preston Urban Management & Timberplay Outdoor Design |
