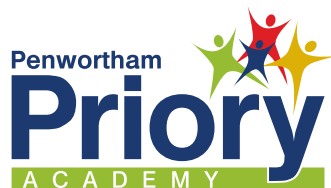


# Catering at Priory

## How To Order & What's On The Menu



# Fresh home cooked meals and snacks available daily.

- Hot meals, light bites and snacks to eat in or take away
- Vegetarian, vegan, halal and gluten-free options available daily
- Main meal choices changed weekly.
- No cash needed

There's a great choice with a three-week rolling lunch specials menu which will be displayed around school, on the year group Teams and in the weekly newsletter.

All food served conforms to the Government Food Standards for Schools.

Prices and menu items are subject to change.

**Pupils have the option purchase hot or cold food, snacks and drinks directly from the dining rooms to eat in or take away using their ID card to make payment\*. In addition, there are various 'grab & go' options, including baked potatoes, served at the Pod.**

## Self Service Kiosks

Pupils order their drinks, snacks and meals using the user-friendly touchscreen kiosks, similar to those found in fast food restaurants. These kiosks help us make break and lunchtimes quicker and smoother.

**To use the kiosks, pupils must have their school ID card**, which is used to deduct the cost of their purchases from their lunch account\*. The secure, cashless kiosks link to pupils' SCOPay accounts, and Free School Meal allowances are automatically added to eligible pupils' accounts each day.

When a pupil presents their ID card at the food ordering kiosk, a display will show their photo, name and available balance held within the system. They should then navigate their way through the system to select food and drink of choice.

Staff are always on hand to guide pupils through the process and answer any questions.

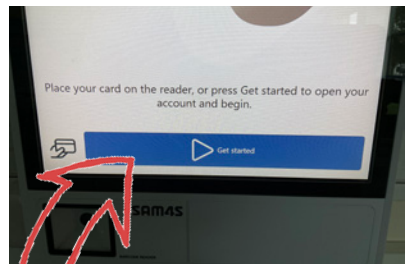




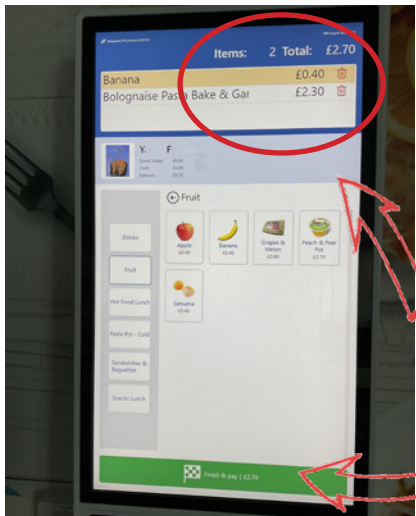
Tap ID card here



The top of the screen displays the items selected alongside their individual cost. The total number of items and their cost is shown just above it. Next to the pupil's photo is a real time balance and pupils can reselect their choices according to their available funds. Please note the system sets a maximum daily spend of £6.



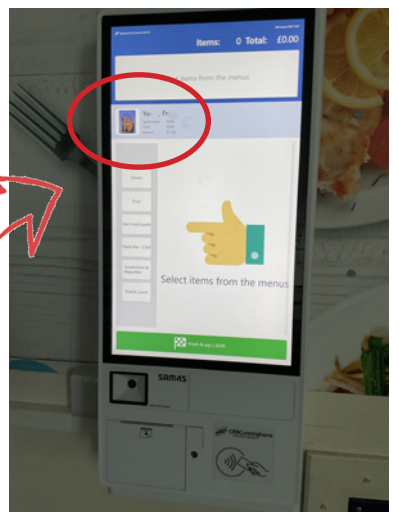
Then tap here to get started.



To confirm the order, tap the green 'Finish & Pay' button at the bottom of the screen. The account is then debited to the value of the items purchased and the kiosk will issue a paper receipt. Pupils should then take the receipt to the counter where the catering team will prepare the order ready to collect.

Hot meals, light food, snacks and drinks will be served fresh at break and lunch from the Restaurant for pupils in Years 7, 8 & 9, and from the Bistro for pupils in Year 10 & 11. No cash is required as the pupil's ID card will be used to deduct payment from their account\* at the kiosks.

## The Pod, our new 'Grab & Go' facility for all year groups



The Pod was officially opened in December 2024 and is situated between the Science block and the 3G pitch.

This facility is open to all year groups and serves light meals, snacks and drinks to-go.

Pupils will order directly with the catering staff and items will be charged using the pupil's ID card.

## Packed lunches

Pupils who wish to bring in their own food may eat in their year group areas or the dining room with their friends who have chosen to eat in.

We also have numerous picnic benches scattered around the estate.

## Pupils who receive Free School Meals (FSM)

Pupils entitled to FSM can purchase at the kiosks too, just like everyone else. Their choice of food/drink will be taken from their daily allowance of £2.80.

This allowance can be used at break and/or lunchtime. Any leftover balance cannot be carried over to the next day.



**Vending machines** offer a wide selection of bottled drinks. These are located in the Bistro (the Year 10 & 11 dining room) and at the back of the Sports Hall, which crosses the Year 7 & 8 area. Drinks can only be paid for with cash or contactless card payment (there is no ID card scanner).

## Hot Drinks

Exclusively for our Year 10 & 11 pupils and staff, we also have a hot drinks vending machine in the Bistro. All drinks are 60p each and must be paid for with cash or contactless card payment.

Pupils must not take hot drinks out of the Bistro area.
