

Departmental CEIAG Plan 2023-24 – Child Development

Activity	Outcome
Careers display in the classroom	Pupils are provided with information of how to further extend their Child Development qualifications post 16 and signposted to variety of future career opportunities. The display is within the classroom and accessible to all.
Guest speakers	Pupils have access to guest speakers from local colleges or local childcare professionals. This gives them opportunities to gain information, guidance and to ask questions about future career paths and educational routes.
Careers week	All subjects will participate in Careers week, delivering CEIAG information as part of lesson content such as qualifications required, skills required, job description, salary and career prospects. Pupils here are directed to our school Careers Advisor
Work experience	Pupils are given priority to apply for work placements at the childcare settings and primary schools in our local area.
Apprenticeship Information	Information on Apprenticeships available within local childcare settings is shared and promoted within the cohort. Pupils are supported in application of these.
College taster days	Pupils are given to opportunity to attend taster days at local colleges and sample lessons within both the Childcare and Health Care sectors.
