

## **What does homework look like in Food**

Tasks are never set for the sake of setting homework. Food homework should be accessible for all pupils.

KS3 homework will consist of 6-7 tasks per rotation (each rotation lasts for one term) and there will be a variety of activities including:

- Reading and comprehension tasks
- Knowledge checks
- Online quizzes
- Recall checks

The above may be through worksheets, websites, Microsoft Teams Forms, physical handouts, etc. Pupils generally have one week to complete tasks.

KS4 homework consists of sourcing ingredients, engaging with theoretical knowledge for the examination and theoretical knowledge and research for the controlled assessments.

As well as the methods described for KS3, pupils will be directed to relevant resources such as Seneca, BBC Bitesize, revision guides and class resources and encouraged to produce mind maps, revision cards and other resources to support their learning. Pupils generally receive one homework pre week at this key stage.

If a pupil fails to meet a homework deadline, normal whole school sanctions will be applied.
