Overview

In Year 7 pupils are taught Geography for 2 hours per week, and cover the topics of:

- Geographical Skills
- The United Kingdom
- Weather & Climate (incl. fieldwork)
- All About Africa
- Economic Activity and Development
- Water & The UK

In Year 8 pupils are taught Geography for 2 hours per week, and cover the topics of:

- Plate Tectonics
- Population & Urbanisation
- Natural Resources
- Tourism (incl. fieldwork)
- Glaciation

In Year 9 pupils are taught Geography for 2 hours per week, and cover the topics of:

- Sustainable Living
- Extreme Environments
- Coasts
- Forests of The World
- Rivers
- Crime & GIS

In Year 10 & 11 pupils are taught Geography for 3 hours per week, following the Edexcel Geography Specification A Syllabus.

In Year 10, pupils cover the topics of:

- Changing Cities (incl. fieldwork)
- Global Development
- Weather Hazards & Climate Change

In Year 11, pupils cover the topics of:

- UK Landscapes (incl. coasts & rivers)
- Ecosystems, Biodiversity & Management
- Resource Management
