The careers' programme provides pupils information of the variety of career paths available with associated routes into training and employment, all with an explicit link to the curriculum.

As an EBacc subject, History can provide a sound basis for a variety of careers beyond the age of 16, therefore it is the responsibility of all staff within the department to support students to identify essential skills they develop through exposure to our curriculum and how that links to potential careers outside of our curriculum.

We support initiatives such as National Apprenticeships Week (WB Monday 10th February 2025) and National Careers Week (WB Monday 3rd March 2025) as well making links within our subject when appropriate.

We also incorporate outside speakers, such as visitors from UCLan who will meet with Key Stage Four pupils to discuss their work within History as an academic role.
