Homework in History

KS3

At KS3 there is a set pattern of homework. This is recorded using the whole school policy on platforms such as Synergy and Teams so that both students and parents can access and view any work set.

During any one topic, there are 3 set homework opportunities. These are outlined below:

- Key word spelling test revision
- A reading task relating to the topic
- Revision for an end of unit test

Homework forms an integral part of revisiting work that has been taught in lesson. Any homework missed must be completed at a time out of structured lesson time.

KS4

At KS4, topics typically span an entirety of a full term. Each week, students will complete an exam style question based on the learning over the course of the week which will then be marked at the next opportunity in lesson by the classroom teacher.

Towards the end of any topic or unit, additional homework such as end of unit revision may be set. This may take place online on platforms such as GCSE Pod, Seneca or Teams to aid revision
