

# History marking and feedback guidelines

## Key Stage 3

### *Marking*

Each topic has one piece of assessed writing that assesses a particular skill within History. This is marked by the classroom teacher who provides feedback based on the content of the answer and any SPaG errors. Each topic has an end of topic test that is marked by the teacher. Moderation of tasks is undertaken.

### *Feedback*

Pupils are given feedback every lesson through oral comments and through the DIRT work that is done. DIRT should be completed in green pen whether it is a standard class-based task, an assessed answer or the end of topic assessment.

## Key Stage 4

### *Marking*

There are assessed pieces of work that are assigned to each topic to assess skills needed for the GCSE examinations. These are reviewed and agreed by GCSE staff each academic year to ensure that all classes are assessed in the same way. Pupil's responses are marked and given a numbered mark by the member of staff. Moderation of longer pieces is undertaken.

### *Feedback*

As at Key Stage 3, feedback is an integral part to all lessons.
