

Religious Education marking and feedback guidelines

Key Stage 3

Marking

Each topic has one piece of assessed writing that assesses a particular skill within RE. This is marked by the classroom teacher who provides feedback based on the content of the answer and any SPaG errors. Each topic has a topic test that is marked by the teacher. Moderation of tasks is undertaken.

Feedback

Pupils are given feedback every lesson through oral comments and through the DIRT work that is done. DIRT should be completed in green pen whether it is a standard class-based task, an assessed answer or the topic assessment.

Key Stage 4

Marking

There are assessed pieces of work that are assigned to each topic to assess the needs for the GCSE examinations. These are reviewed and agreed each academic year to ensure that all students are assessed in the same way. Pupil's responses are marked and given a numbered mark by the member of staff. Moderation of longer pieces is undertaken.

Feedback

As at Key Stage 3, feedback is an integral part to all lessons.
